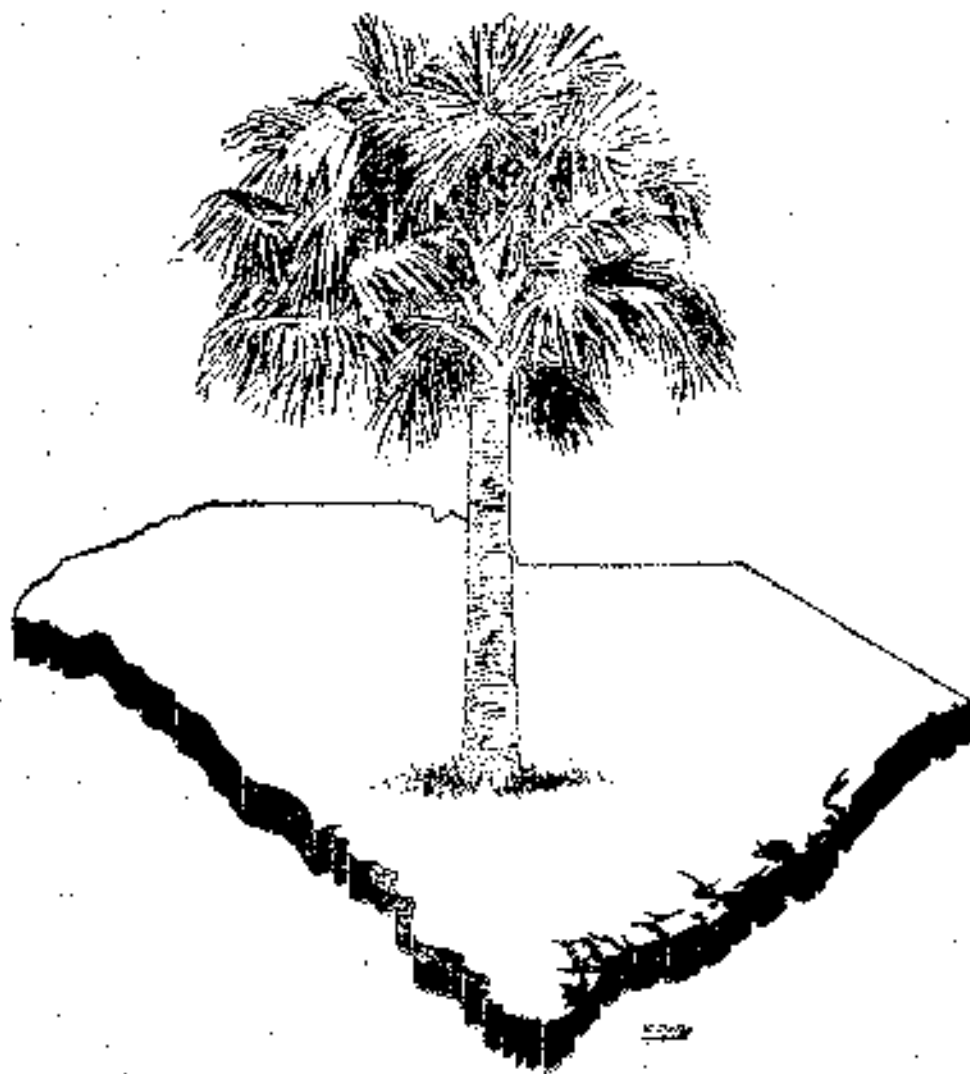


SIXTH ANNUAL CONCLAVE

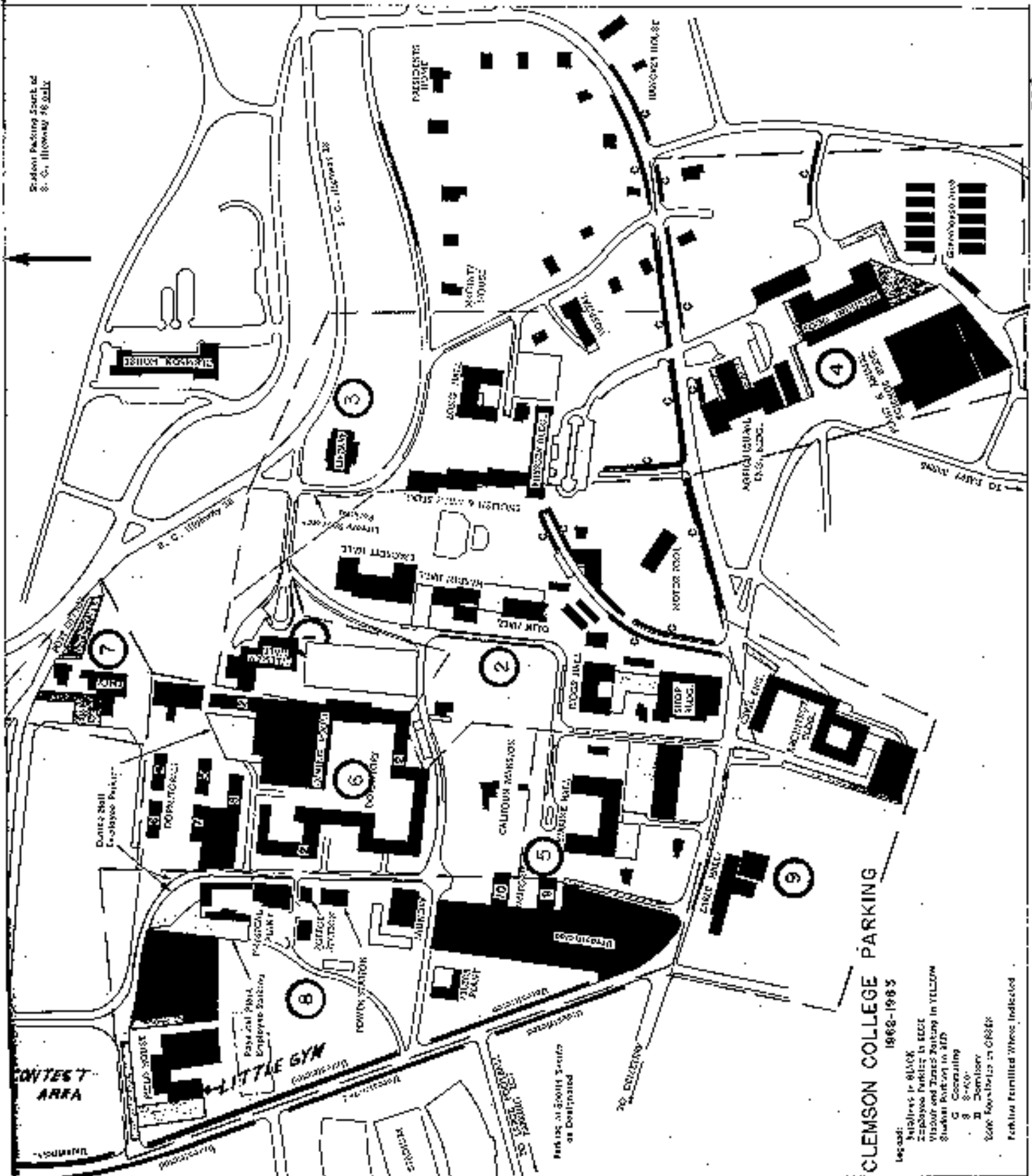
